8. ABSENT MEMBER SCORING

~~In the event that a player is unable to play on a particular night and has failed to arrange for a substitute, the remaining Team member can play against the opposing team. Single player team will be allowed 1 Mulligan per hole. The single player will establish a new HCP the first time they play alone and will not effect the team HCP. Should the same single player play again they will continue to create a HCP as any other sub would.~~ In the event that a player is unable to play on a particular night and has not arranged for a substitute, the remaining team member may play solo against the opposing team. The single player will be allowed one Mulligan per hole. On their first solo appearance, they will establish a handicap (HCP) and be entered into the system as a substitute. Their score will not affect the team handicap. If the same player plays solo again, they will continue to be treated as a substitute. *Their score will count for points purposes only.*

In the event both regular team members are absent and one sub shows up to play. The sub would play against the opposing team,. The same as a single player.

In the event both members of one team are absent (with no subs) the opposing team would play as scheduled and would use the absent team handicap and add 4 strokes). Under this scenario the absent team would not receive any points but the opposing team would need to beat absent teams score.

In the event opposing teams are scheduled to play and neither team has players or arranged for subs both teams would receive 0 points each.
